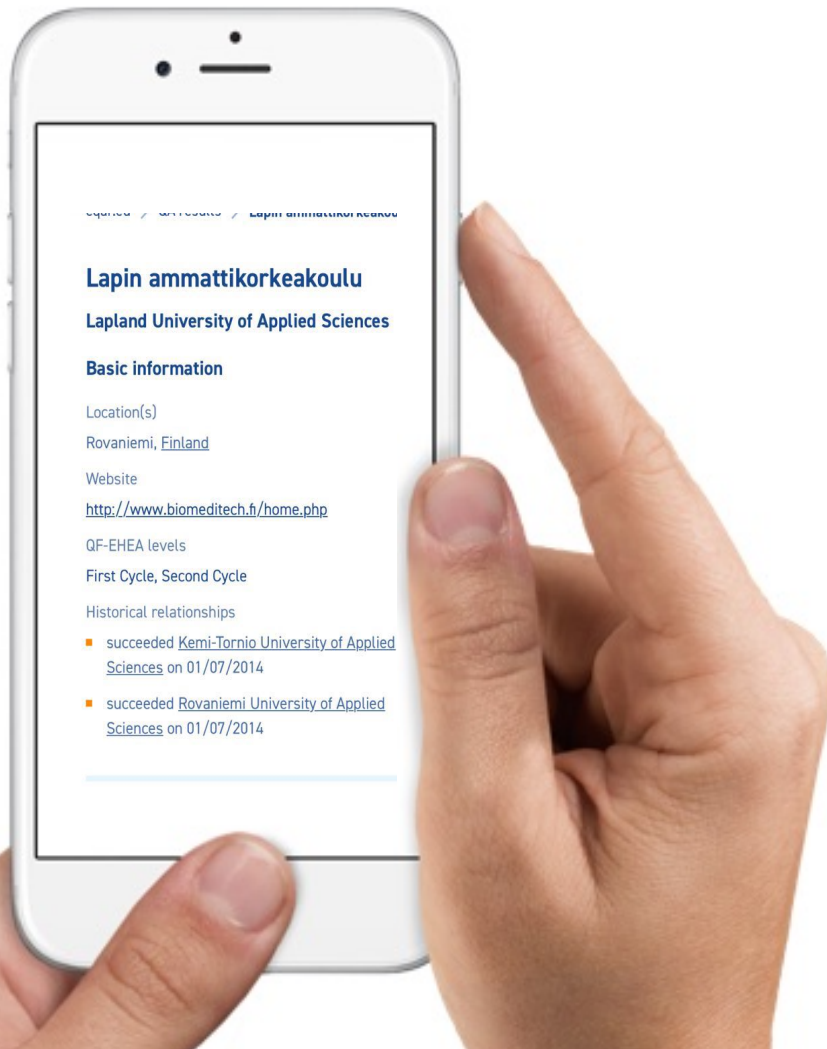

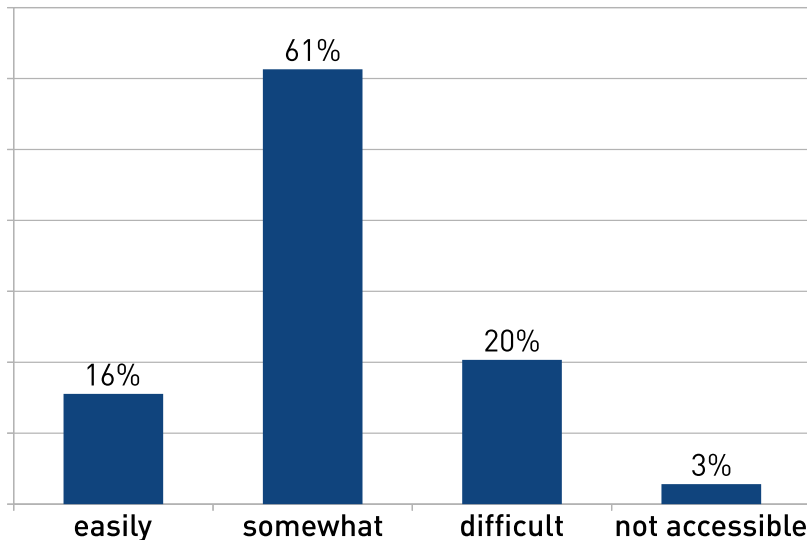

Background



Source: EQAR survey of potential users, 2016 (n=384)

- No optimal accessibility of quality assurance (QA) results
- Automatic recognition agenda (EHEA goal, EU recommendation)
- Need for easy access and understanding of QA

Approach



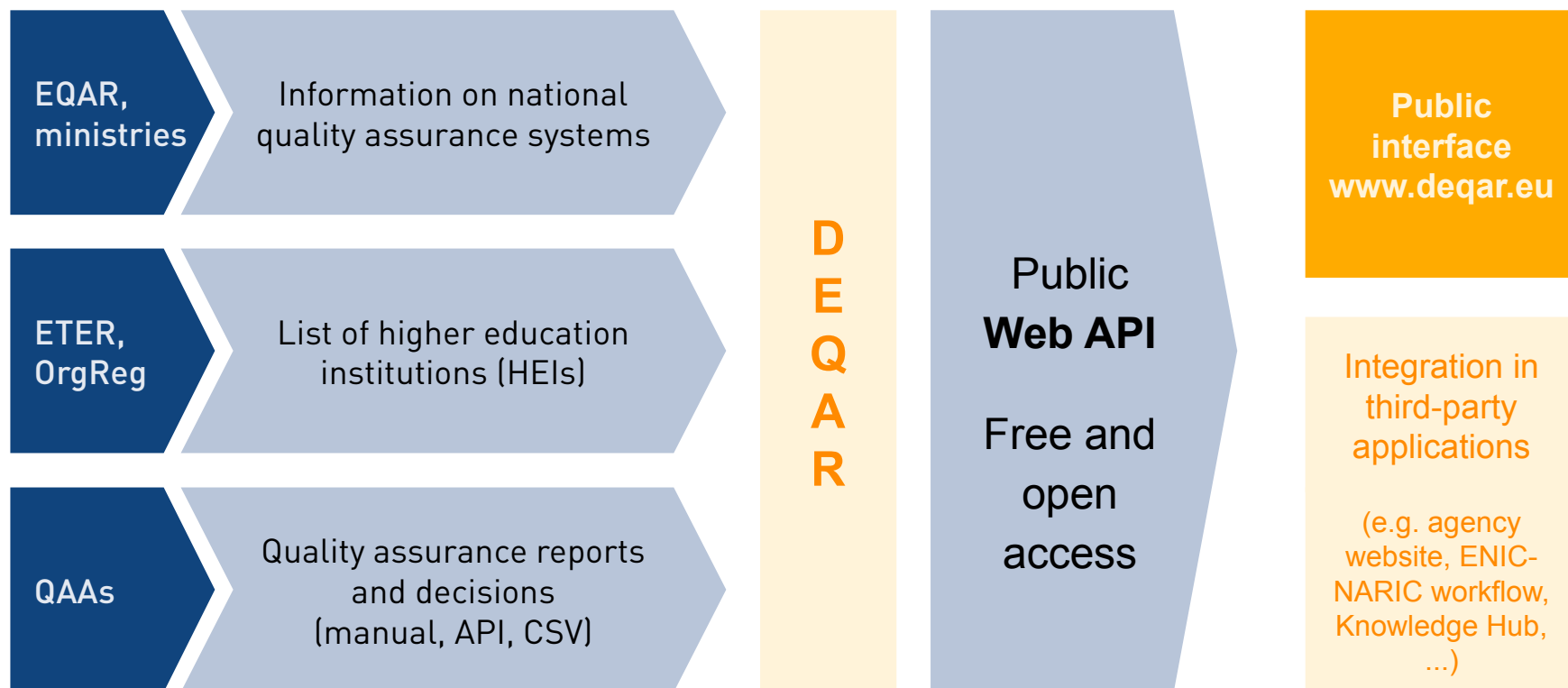
Aim:

- Collect all external QA reports/decisions by EQAR-registered agencies
- Map diversity of European QA systems
- Open to link up with other tools

Design principles:

- Lean approach
- Contextual information
- Low entry barrier for QA agencies
- Re-use what exists
- Free and open access

Historic records



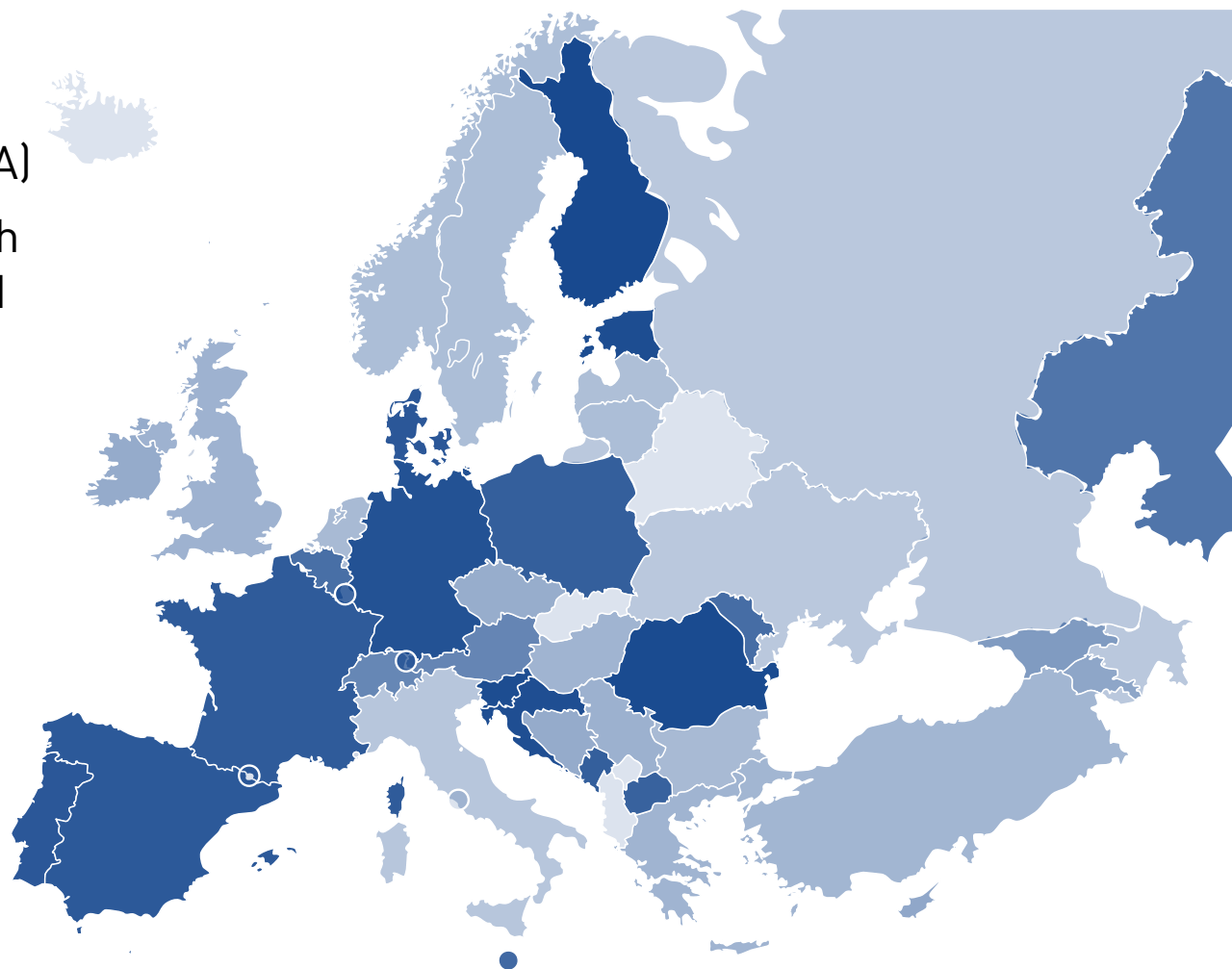
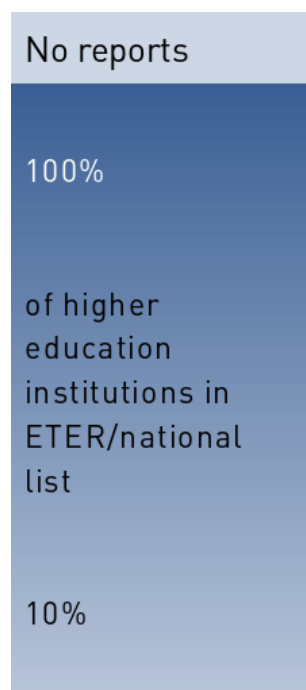
Full download

Key figures & coverage

- **46 970 reports**
- 2 202 HEIs in 67 countries (42 EHEA)
- 16 EHEA systems with >50% of HEIs covered



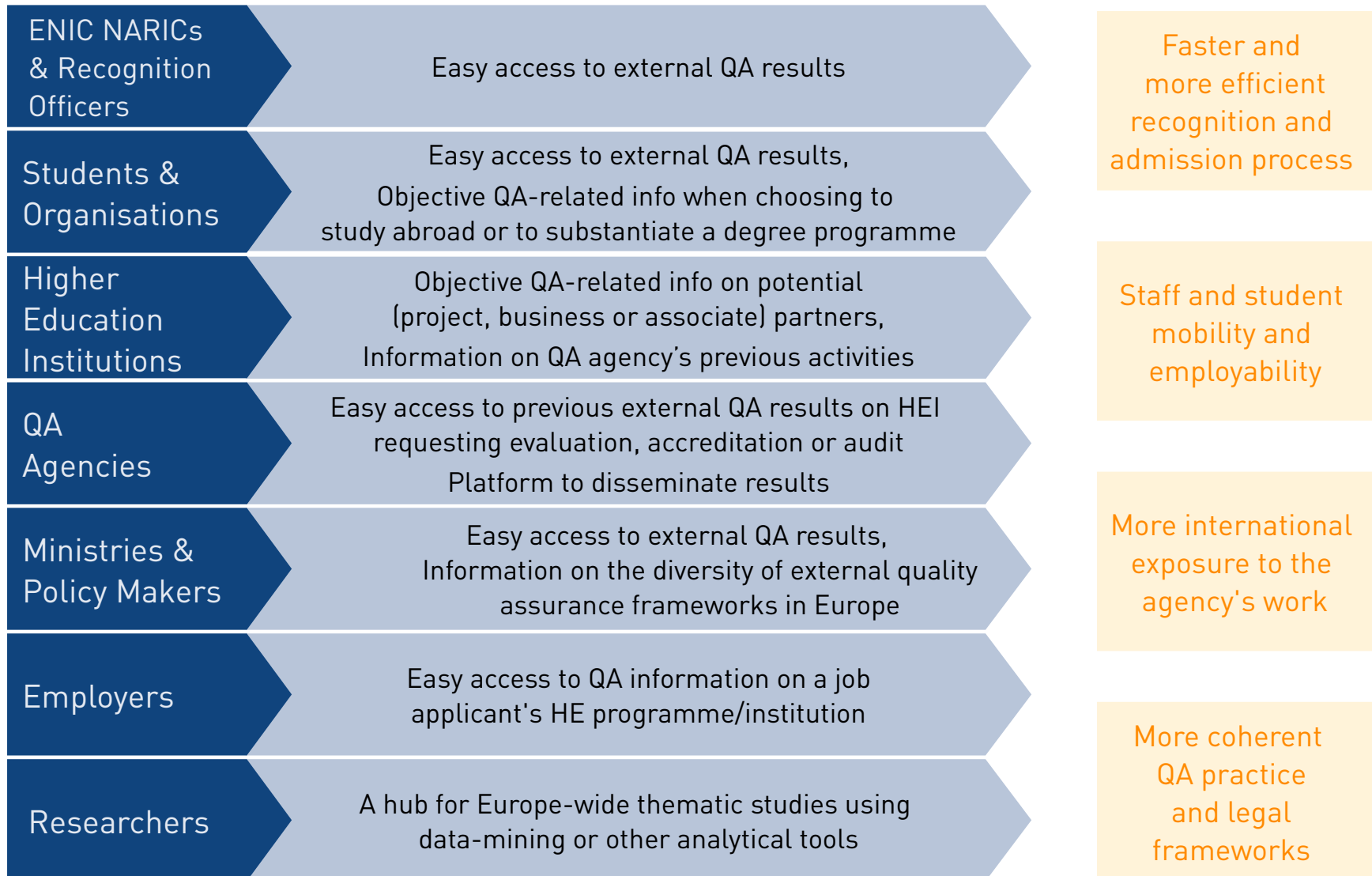

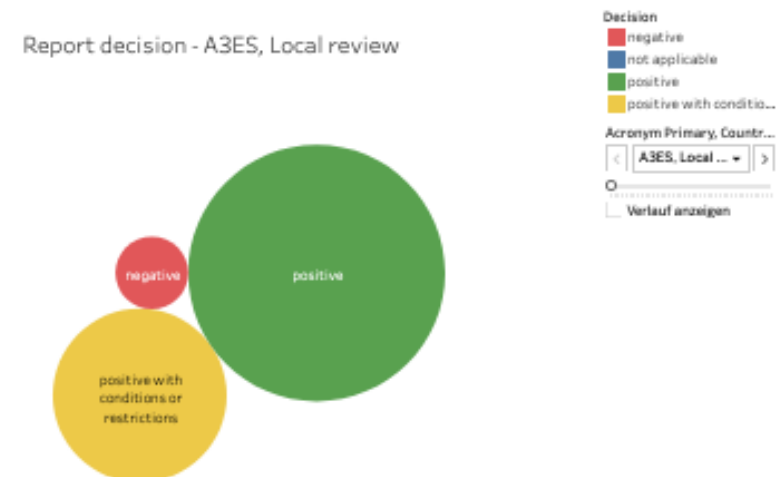
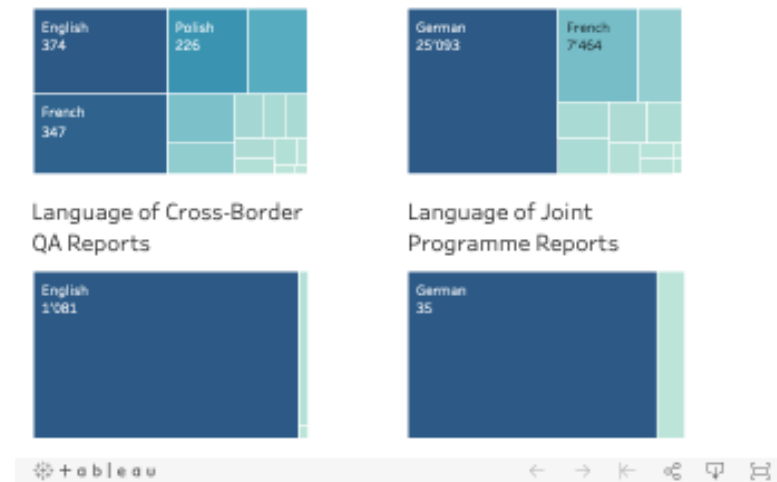
